Meet the Heinke Family Alvadorians Since 1974

Solar Energy



With the cost of energy in the future unknown, the search for an environmentally conscious alternative renewable energy source continues. After a year of having solar panels, both Kat Gottfried (Eugene)& Chris Marler (Alvadore) say yes, **SOLAR IS WORTH IT**!

The price and efficiency for solar panels may seem expensive or not worth it but it really depends on your Chris had panels installed by a private house size, electricity use and weather. Between the two homes, the price varied between \$20k and \$50k before tax deductions and \$5k state incentive. Financial assistance seems to be readily available for short or long term loans.

How do I Receive Electricity from my Solar Panels? Your electricity provider sends you a watt for every watt you generate. They install a meter on your home to track how much electricity your panels are making. If your panels don't generate enough electricity you pay for more. If you make extra, your provider keeps track and lets you use your extra before buying more. Some people may have to buy some electricity during the winter months (like Kat) but some people may make enough extra in the summer to never pay an electric bill again.

Will Adding Solar Panels Increase your Home Value? At this time, there have not been enough sales in the area to make a good comparative study. Many factors come into consideration when purchasing a home. Typically, a large consideration for a buyer is the cost of replacement for major items like Decks, Heating and Air Conditioning Systems, Roofs and Appliances as well as Solar Panels. With these items the age of the systems is a factor.

solar contractor. Kat went with National Solar based in Bend. The process was nearly identical for both people. The whole process for them took about a month once started.

- 1. Have your home assessed to see if solar panels are right for you.
- 2. Pick the right system for your house.
- 3. Receive approval permits from the county and coordinate with your **electricity provider**. (Took them about a week)
- 4. Purchase the Panels.
- 5. Install the Panels. (Took them 1-2days)

What are the Requirements to Install Solar Panels? - Requirements depend on your electricity provider but typically they are:

- 1. Obtain **2 estimates** from contractors approved by your utility company.
- 2. Condition of Your Roof your solar panel life expectancy (about 20 years) should be the same as your roof life expectancy
- 3. Placement and Orientation of Your House - your house may not be facing the right direction or may be too Having a large southern facing, unobstructed roof is best
